POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES

	'B' remains silent	'B' betrays 'A'
'A' remains SILENT	each serves 6 months jail	'A' gets 10 yrs 'B' goes free
'A' betrays 'B'	'A' goes free 'B' gets 10 yrs	each serves 5 years jail
